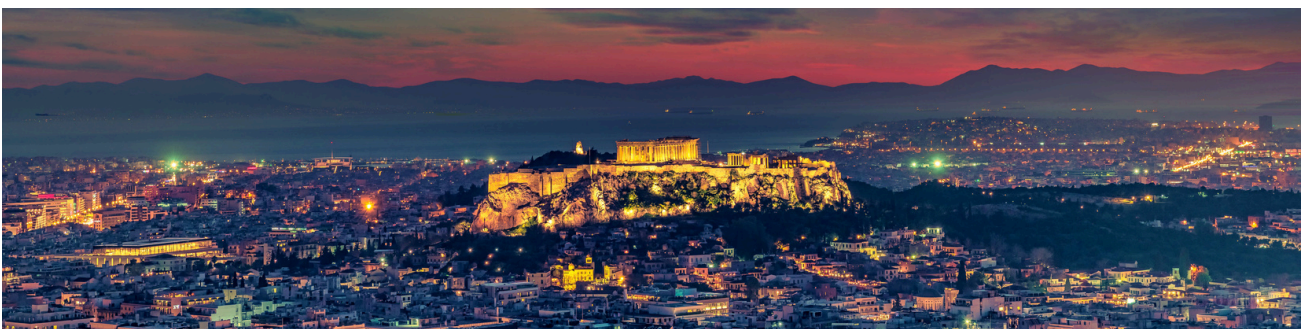
Day 1: Arrival at Athens

- **Arrival:** Arrive at El. Venizelos Airport
- **Hotel Check-in:** After clearing immigration and collecting baggage, you'll head to a 4-star hotel in Athens for a one-night stay with breakfast included.
- **Free and Easy Evening:** After you check-in, you've got the whole evening to do whatever you want in Athens. You can walk around the hotel area, check out nearby cool stuff, or try some yummy food around town. It's all up to you!

Day 2: Delphi

- Drive through Boeotia, a fertile area.
- Pass by Thebes, Livadia, and the pretty village of Arachova.
- **Arrive in Delphi** and check out the Archaeological Site.
- Head to Kalambaka, a small town near the amazing Meteora rocks.
- Have dinner and stay overnight in Delphi.
- Delphi, Greece, at night, is magical. You can stroll through the streets, enjoying the peace and quiet.



Day 03: Meteora to Thessaloniki

- Visit the Meteora: Monasteries on top of huge rocks that look like they are floating in the air.
- See beautiful Byzantine art in these ancient Monasteries.
- Depart from Kalambaka.
- Drive through the plain of Thessaly.
- Pass through the Valley of Tempis.
- Admire Mount Olympus, the highest mountain in Greece and home to the 12 Greek Gods.
- **Arrive in Thessaloniki**, Greece's second largest and most lively city.
- Have dinner and stay overnight.

Day 04: Explore the Byzantine Legacy

- Morning: Visit the city that was the second most important after Constantinople during the Byzantine Empire.
- Explore unique monuments and experience the rich Byzantine history.
- Visit some of the oldest and most famous churches in the Christian world.
- Tour the Museum of Byzantine Culture, which won the Council of Europe's Museum Prize in 2005.
- Rest of the day: Free time to enjoy the lively city center.
- Dinner and overnight stay included.



Day 05: Historical Macedonia Tour: Edessa, Naoussa, Vergina, and Veria

- Depart in the morning for a unique historical tour of Macedonia.
- First stop at the scenic town of Edessa to see the famous Waterfalls.
- Continue to Naoussa to visit Aristotle's School, where the philosopher taught **Alexander the Great**.
- **Drive to Vergina** (ancient Aigai) to visit the Museum in the Great Tumulus, which covers the royal tombs of Macedonia.
- See amazing discoveries from the tomb of King Philip II, Alexander the Great's father.
- Next, visit Veria (Biblical Beroea) to see Saint Paul's Bema.
- Walk through the old Jewish neighborhood and colorful market area.
- **Return to Thessaloniki** for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 06 : Trip to Pella and Dion, Ending in Athens

- Drive to Pella, the capital of Alexander the Great.
- See beautiful 4th century B.C. floor mosaics in the villas.
- Visit the new Museum.
- Continue to the Archaeological Park of Dion, the sacred city of the Macedonians at the foot of Mount Olympus.
- After visiting **Dion**, drive south through: **Thessaly, Lamia, Thermopylae** (see the Leonidas' Monument), Thebes
- Arrive in **Athens** late in the afternoon.



Day 07: Half-Day Athens Sightseeing with Acropolis Museum

- After breakfast, start your Athens sightseeing tour.
- Observe the city's striking contrasts.
- Visit the Panathenaic Stadium, where the first modern Olympic Games were held in 1896 (short stop).
- Pass by:
 - The Prime Minister's residence (formerly the Royal Palace), is guarded by the Evzones in colorful uniforms.
 - The Temple of Olympian Zeus.
 - Hadrian's Arch.
 - The Parliament and the memorial to the Unknown Soldier.
 - The Academy, the University, and the National Library.
 - Constitution Square (Syntagma).
- On the Acropolis, visit the Golden Age architectural masterpieces:
 - The Propylaea.
 - The Temple of Athena Nike.
 - The Erechtheion.
 - The Parthenon.
- Continue to the Acropolis Museum to see the wonders of the classical era.

Day 08: Free Day in Athens for Shopping and Exploring

- Enjoy a free day in Athens.
- Go shopping in the city center.
- Explore the beautiful alleys.



Day 09: Departure

- After breakfast, transfer from hotel to airport.
- Catch your flight back home.
